VI COOP SAAREMAA CHESS FESTIVAL I REGULATIONS

PURPOSE

To popularise the game of chess in Saaremaa and elsewhere. To introduce Saaremaa and Kuressaare as a great tourist region. Determine the best blitz and rapid chess players of the festival.

1. TIME AND PLACE

VI Coop Saaremaa Chess Festival will take place on 29.05-01.06.2025 in Asa Spa Hotel Kuressaare, Estonia (Pargi 12, 93810).

2. SCHEDULE

Simultaneous exhibition against a Grandmaster

3. REGISTRATION

Pre-registration period would be until **26 May 2025**. Each interested player is required to pay full registration fee in order to participate. Registered players will be published in the Estonian Chess Federation <u>calendar plan</u>.

A player who is not registered before the deadline will be allowed to play based on vacancy. Registration fees for players who register after 26 May 2025 will be doubled.

4. PARTICIPATION FEE

Blitz tournament: 25 EUR

• IM/WIM, youth (b. 2007 or later), seniors (b. 1960 or earlier), Saaremaa residents: 15 EUR

Rapid tournament: 50 EUR

• IM/WIM, youth (b. 2007 or later), seniors (b. 1960 or earlier), Saaremaa residents: 30 EUR

Both tournaments are **free** for GM / WGM titled players.

5. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM AND TIE-BREAK REGULATIONS

The <u>blitz</u> tournament will be played in the Swiss system for 11 rounds. The time control is 3 minutes + 2 seconds per move starting move 1. A player can be late for the round up to 3 minutes.

The <u>rapid</u> tournament will be played in the Swiss system for 11 rounds. The time control is 12 minutes + 5 seconds per move starting move 1. A player can be late for the round up to 5 minutes.

In case of equal points between two or more chess players, the tie-break will be as follows:

- a) results of direct encounters between the tied players
- b) reduced Buchholz-1 (sum of opponents' points excluding the weakest result)
- c) reduced Buchholz-2 (sum of opponents' points excluding the 2 weakest results)
- d) Buchholz (sum of opponents' points)
- e) highest number of games played with black

The tournaments will be played according to FIDE Laws of Chess. All disputes will be resolved by the chief arbiter.
